

Colonne in semi-grès

Tutte le colonne in porcellana vengono realizzate da maestri ceramisti secondo antiche tradizioni artigiane. La porcellana, rispetto alla ceramica, è molto più resistente agli urti e alle scalfiture e non assorbe liquidi né viene intaccata da detergenti. I colori sono più brillanti e rimangono invariati nel tempo. I corpi e relativi coperchi delle colonne in porcellana possono essere personalizzati con marchi indebolibili.

Caratteristiche tecniche

Per ordinare una colonna in porcellana completa occorre richiedere:

- Corpo+coperchio colonna porcellana, specificando modello, diametro, finitura o decoro
- Relativo cerchio rotondo o ellittico, inox o inox dorato con indicazione dei fori e eventuali flange di riduzione o tappi copriforo
- Relativo kit guarnizioni da posizionare tra cerchio e porcellana
- Relativo fissaggio (fix America)
- Eventuali accessori quali rubinetti, raccoligocce, pomelli, tubi di alimentazione, tubi ricircolo, ecc...

Semi-sandstone towers


Porcelain towers are made by master potters with traditional handcrafting techniques. Porcelain, in comparison to ceramic, is much more resistant to shocks and scratches, it does not absorb liquids and cannot be damaged by detergents.

Therefore colours are brighter and more vivid, resisting colour change over prolonged periods of time. Bodies and covers of porcelain towers can be customized with indelible logos.

Technical Features

When ordering a complete tower, the following items are necessary:

- Body + cover of porcelain tower, specifying model, diameter, finish or decoration
- Appropriate round or oval ring in stainless steel or gold-plated stainless steel, indicating the number of holes required, as well as any reduction flanges or hole covers required
- Relatively set of seals for fitting between ring and porcelain
- Appropriate fixing (Fix America)
- Any accessories like taps, drip trays, handles, supply pipes, recirculation tubes, etc.

We can now supply the market with towers in the styles it knows and likes, with the logos and brands of the drinks dispensed, but in a stronger material.

With Semi-Sandstone porcelain, we can also produce handles or even badge holders with logos. The towers are assembled with 304 stainless steel or stainless steel gilt flash turned rings, with a diameter of 100, 120, 130, 150 and 170, for 1, 2, or 3 taps, or with elliptical rings with 3 to 6 taps. Rings for postmix valves, from 4 to 8 valves, are also available.


